
Letter from the President

The more things change the more they remain the same. I know the saying is cliché but it truly reflects the year we had here at NITA.

There were four major changes at NITA in 2010. Geographically, we moved back to our roots in beautiful Boulder, Colorado. Physically, we transformed our teaching facility for more economical and flexible uses. Financially, we operated as a responsible not-for-profit organization with a “balanced budget.” Organizationally, we transitioned into a new leadership era. Lonny Rose retired as President & CEO and the Board of Trustees asked me to step in as NITA’s director. These are monumental changes, but the organization adapted seamlessly. This flawless transition must be credited to a loyal group of program directors and faculty, a committed Board of Trustees, and the hardworking, “lean and mean” NITA staff.

Most organizations that undergo changes of this magnitude would see some adverse impacts throughout the year. Here, though, we adapted and refused to let this transitional time hurt our success. The NITA community made this possible by remaining largely unchanged. Our outstanding faculty has the same dedication and loyalty to the legal profession as always. The tireless administrative staff remained intact and cognizant of the mission. NITA held over 200 programs in 2010, training well over 4,500 attorneys, and released nearly 20 new/revised publications. We also ran a pilot online program for the first time in 2010, which will surely bring new opportunities.

These are impressive numbers for an organization operating in a “business as usual” year. Exceptional numbers when considering the great transition NITA saw in 2010. A special thank you goes out to everyone involved in helping NITA work through these changes. It wouldn’t have been so “easy” without your hard work and dedication. 2011 marks NITA’s 40th Anniversary and there is much to celebrate. Here’s to the next 40 years!

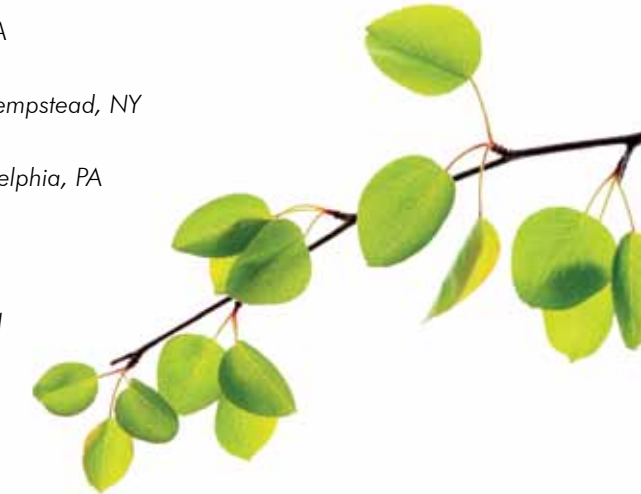

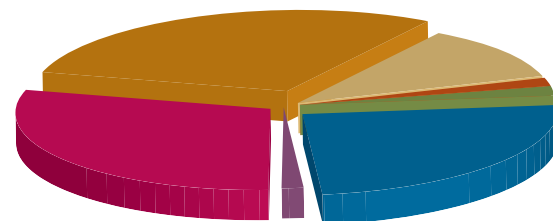

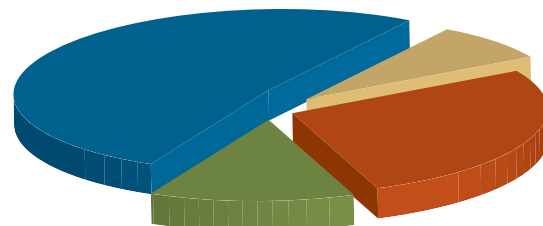
